TAKATA EMERGENCY: NCCIE TAKES CHARGE OF SECURING CHEVROLET VEHICLES IN FRENCH GUIANA

At the request of the manufacturer Stellantis, NCCIE will now ensure the safety of Chevrolet brand vehicles as part of the Takata airbag recall. Although the brand withdrew from European markets at the end of 2015, NCCIE was the distributor until then, and some vehicles may also have been imported into French Guiana from other markets, by agents or as part of moves.

NCCIE will therefore take charge of replacing Takata airbags on Chevrolet Aveo T300, Avalanche, Cruze, Orlando, Silverado, Suburban, Tahoe and Trax models, produced between 2007 and 2017.

<u>We invite owners to immediately stop using their vehicle and</u> to contact us without delay.

Since 2018, Toyota has organized numerous Takata recall campaigns around the world. Thanks to these campaigns, the NCCIE was able to change 1,885 airbags on Toyota vehicles in French Guiana, but there are still 1,589 dangerous vehicles to find. Similarly, we still have 270 Ford vehicles and 760 Opel vehicles affected by the Takata recall to find and secure.

This is a race against time because the wear and age of vehicles increases the risk of fatal accidents. We therefore call on all drivers of the vehicles concerned to go to a workshop free of charge to secure their vehicles.

About the Takata crisis:

The Takata airbag crisis concerns a serious safety problem linked to airbags manufactured by the Japanese company Takata. This crisis erupted following the discovery that some of these airbags could rupture during deployment, posing a potentially fatal risk. These failures have been associated with serious injuries and even deaths. The airbags in question were primarily installed between 2002 and 2017 by 19 automakers, spanning 34 brands worldwide. By the end of 2023, there had been more than 30 deaths worldwide, including 26 in the United States, related to these failures. Takata airbag explosions have injured more than 400 people worldwide.
